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The Award

The MUNA Federal Credit Union High School Senior Scholarship program offers five (5) non-recurring awards of \$1,000 each.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a member, a child, or grandchild of a member in good standing with MUNA Federal Credit Union. A sponsoring member's name and member number is required on the entry documentation if the student is not a member.
- Applicant must be a 2025 high-school graduating senior and accepted to an accredited 2- or 4-year institution and attending college or vocational/technical school for the first time. Scholarship must be used exclusively to pay the tuition or associated costs of named winner only at an accredited 2- or 4-year institution/vocational/technical school.
- Applicants consent to MUNA FCU's use of their name, statements and likeness without compensation in any and all promotional and advertising activity, both print and online.

Application Procedure Guidelines

Each applicant may submit only one entry. To be considered eligible, applicants must provide the following documentation:

- A completed and legibly signed entry form. Both the student and a parent/guardian must sign the form, confirming the originality of the essay and the accuracy and completeness of all submitted information to the best of the applicant's knowledge.
- An original essay, between 500 and 700 words in length, on the assigned topic. The essay must be typewritten in English. It must be double-spaced and typed in either Times New Roman or Calibri font, size 12, in either Word or RTF (Rich Text Format). **If submitting via email, the judges must receive the essay in document form (Word or RTF), not jpg, jpeg, PNG, or any "image" form.** NOTE: Essay must be a separate file from the application.
- Proof of acceptance from an accredited 2- or 4-year institution (college or vocational/technical school).

Applicants must follow the specified formatting guidelines and complete all sections of the application for consideration. No additional attachments, resumes, photographs, or other materials should be included or utilized to address any questions.
